Ladies and gentlemen are encouraged to wear their most fetching hats in the spirit of Derby day.

The official drink of Churchill Downs and the Kentucky Derby for nearly a century, mint juleps will be flowing. The Inn's version is made with Woodford Reserve Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey, mint-infused simply syrup and finished with a splash of seltzer and a sprig of mint. Other popular horse race cocktail contenders are the Oaks Lily[®], the official drink of the Kentucky Oaks, made with Grey Goose vodka, sweet and sour mix and cranberry juice and the Horse's Neck cocktail named for its long-coiled lemon peel that snakes around the inside of the glass mixed with a special-made WaDuke-infused Woodford Reserve and ginger ale.
